### **Responsibilities:**

This position will be responsible for managing the USFS abandoned mine lands (AML) program in Oregon and Washington and will also assist with developing additional AML contracts. Work would consist of the following:

- Responsible for managing the proposal development and implementation of projects under CES' USFS AML contract in Oregon and Washington. Annual contract levels range from \$1.5M to \$2.5M, depending on types of projects.
- Types of projects are listed below:
  - Work Plans (including sampling and analyses, and health and safety plans)
  - Site Inspections (SIs)
  - Engineering Evaluations / Cost Analysis (EECAs)
  - Risk Assessments (Human and Ecological)
  - Removal Actions (RA), including design-build procurement options and post RA monitoring
- Works in a matrix organization with Marketing, Accounting, Operations, and Sector Leaders.
- Responsible for maintaining positive customer relationships with USFS Contracting Officers Reps (CORs) in Oregon and Washington that promotes future business.
- This position would also assist with other engineering and environmental programs, including but not limited to spill prevention countermeasure and control plans (SPCCs), wastewater treatment and reuse, and general environmental/engineering consulting.
- Travel would be limited to conducting fieldwork, primarily in the spring and summer, from a few days to several weeks.
