

Comp Sci 670 Guidelines

Grading: Each person's grade for the project will be an average of the individual and team grade. Team grade will depend on total results (technical), presentation, and team work. Individual grade will depend largely on the report (technical and quality, including grammar*)

*non-native English speakers tend to get a somewhat of a break.

Presentations

Expected length: 20 minutes. Excessively long (more than 35) or short (less than 15) will result in reduced points. Each team member should present their part of the work. The presentation should have a clear introduction showing objectives. The presentation should also have a concluding slide showing conclusions. Sufficient technical detail should be presented to support conclusions. Any problems that arose should be discussed (sometimes this is the most useful part). Any assistance from others should be mentioned.

A copy of the powerpoint should be provided to me.

Reports. Roughly 6 pages; less than 4 or more than 12 may result in loss of points. The introductory page should include an overview of the team's objectives and a brief summary of what the rest of the team is doing and how this work is related to the entire team's objectives. Graphs, etc, can be included. The majority of the report should discuss, in clear and concise fashion, what was done and the results as well as any problems. Suggestions for the future should be made.

- Reports (within one week of presentation)
- Tutorial documentation on CUDA for use of other students (may be turned in later)
